Do you have faith in Christ to give you life? Not just life after death or physical existence, but the inspiration and vitality to feel filled with the life of God that empowers us to live faithfully and minister to others. Do we believe that when we feel discouraged, unmotivated, and drained of enthusiasm and that Christ gives life to inspire us to continue to live for Him? We look to a number of places to encourage us, to place within us a meaning and purpose that lights a fire within our souls. Inspirational events, education, impassioned sermons and messages, and personal engagement with other believers are just a few ways that we can feel renewed and filled with life again. Yet, do we believe that God is able to give us life beyond these other means? Is there a miraculous work of God occurring in the life of believers which offers them inspiration, life, and passion?

Isaiah prophesied about a time when God would offer to His people sustenance and life giving nourishment for which they would not have to pay, a day when God would provide His life giving power to anyone who desired it at no cost. In John 4, Jesus told the Samaritan woman at the well that He was the one who offered this water. Jesus would say multiple times about Himself that He was the bread and water of life. When we join in the Lord's Supper, we are reminded about the life that He gives us by sharing in His body and blood, the loaf and cup. We can receive those at no cost to us because Christ has already paid the price.

The life that He gives us is His Holy Spirit. It is God's own Spirit that comes into us as the giver of life. The Spirit supplies us with water that is so great it pours out of us. The Spirit comes into our lives as a stream of living water. The image of a stream is important. He is not a described as a pool of living water, but a

stream, a body of moving water. The Spirit is meant to come into us, but simultaneously to pour out of us. This is where our faith in His work becomes so vital. Do we believe that we can pour out the life within us on others and trust that as we do it will continue to be refilled?

Too often in the church, people focus on being filled and not on being poured out. We continually look for places for others to fill us up, but when do we look for others to pour ourselves out upon? When do we seek others who need to be encouraged, taught, or built up or ask God who He needs us to pour into with the life He has placed within us? It takes great faith to live this life. It takes faith to believe that what we pour out on another, God will by some means replenish that life within us. This is the life that we see Jesus living as He was filled with the Spirit and looked to pour out His life on others.


It was Jesus common practice to draw alone to deserted places to pray (Luke 5:16). Yet, throughout the rest of His ministry we see Him going to the lepers, to the lame, to sinners in need of salvation and many other places where He served others and gave life to others. He sought out thousands to feed and not to be fed by. If we are to follow in the life of faithfulness and trust in the power of the Holy Spirit that Jesus displayed, we need to seek people who are in need of God's life giving Spirit to be poured out on them.


